- 4. Clothing members are encouraged to bring their patterns and guide sheets with them to Clothing Revue.
- 5. Each garment should have a 3x5" card with member's name and club displayed during the fair. Bring items in on entry day.
- 6. STATE FAIR CLOTHING REVUE is a wonderful opportunity for youth to become involved in clothing project outside of the county. To insure that Adams County has representation, two (2) qualified youth will be annually sent to State Fair Clothing Revue. Whenever possible, preference will be given to youths who have not previously attend a State Fair Clothing Revue.
