

## **Department 35— School Exhibits**

**Each school exhibit will be responsible for set-up.**

**School exhibits will be judged.**

**Schools are responsible for the removal of exhibit(s) after 4:00pm Sunday, the last day of the fair.**

All premiums will be paid directly to the school or department making the exhibit.

Exhibits will be judged according to appearance, quality of work, variety, spread balance, initiative and originality. Youth should do all the work. Limited to 15 entries per exhibit and no more than one exhibit per youth. Emphasis placed on entire youth exhibits instead of individual competition. The exhibited project should be a cooperative school or department activity. Groups may use their own judgment in setting up the exhibit display. All exhibits are to be arranged by and paid for by the school.
